

GB: User Manual, Disposal, and Safety Instructions for an Extendable Table with Metal Guide



1. Introduction

This manual describes the proper use and maintenance of an extendable table with metal guides. Please read the entire manual carefully before using the table.

2. Description of the Table

The extendable table with metal guides is a piece of furniture that allows for length adjustment, enabling you to save space or provide additional seating during larger gatherings. The metal guides may have sharp edges, so caution should be exercised during use.

3. Safety Rules

-  Keep children away from the mechanism.
 -  Do not exceed the maximum weight capacity of the table.
 - Before using the table, check that all components are securely fastened and free of damage.
 - Use the table as intended and avoid overloading it.
 - Do not use the table as a ladder or support.
 - Do not allow children to play with the table or the metal guides.
 - Always exercise caution when extending and collapsing the table to avoid injuries to hands or fingers on the edges of the guides.
 - Keep in mind that the table may bend slightly when extended due to applied forces; avoid excessive loading.
- Warning for children:** The table contains metal guides with edges that may cause injuries. Children should always be under adult supervision while using the table.

4. Extending and Collapsing the Table

- Ensure the area around the table is free of obstacles.
- Stand in the middle of the longer side of the table, holding both sides.
- Remove the lock (if present) that prevents accidental extension of the table.
- Carefully and evenly pull both parts of the table apart, paying attention to the metal guides and their sharp edges.
- Once the table is extended to the desired width, place additional boards (if provided) in the center of the table.
- If the table is equipped with a locking mechanism, lock it to ensure stability during use.
- To collapse the table, unlock the mechanism (if present), remove the additional boards (if provided), and carefully slide both parts of the table together, exercising caution.
- Caution: The lift mechanism may rise during assembly and use.


5. Maintenance and Cleaning

- Wipe the surface of the table with a damp cloth. Do not use aggressive alcohol-based cleaners, especially on acrylic tables.
- Keep the contact edges clean, especially at the joints of the tabletop. After using a damp cloth, ensure these areas are thoroughly dried to prevent damage and prolong the table's lifespan.
- Regularly check and clean the metal guides and other components to ensure proper functionality. Be cautious of sharp edges on the guides during maintenance.

6. Storage

- Store the table in a dry, cool room, away from direct sunlight, to prevent damage to the surface and metal parts.
 - Avoid placing heavy items on the folded table to prevent damage to its structure.
- Following these usage and safety guidelines will ensure long-lasting and safe use of the extendable table with metal guides.

7. Disposal Instructions

 **Recycling Instructions:** The disassembly of the table should be carried out by two people.




- Separate the metal parts from the wooden and composite parts.
- Unscrew the metal legs, guides, and other components from the tabletop using appropriate tools (e.g., a screwdriver or wrench).

Material Segregation:

- **Metal legs and components:** Place them in a metal recycling bin or take them to a metal recycling collection point.
- **Wooden or composite boards:** These cannot be recycled as wood because they contain adhesives and chemical coatings. Take them to a local bulky waste collection point or construction waste facility.
- **Plastic components:** Remove them and dispose of them in an appropriate plastic recycling bin.
